Answers

This stamp was issued in three different formats to meet the expected demand.	
The first large format bi-color, commemorative issue.	
While this stamp was issued to commemorate an actual event, the central design of the stamp illustrates an event that most historians agree never happened.	
This overprint was officially released to commemorate the Battle of Monmouth, but unless you already knew that, it would be difficult to figure it out!	
This extremely crowded design was widely panned-issued for 135 th Anniversary of a battle, very little of anything in this design and execution works.
