Dear Members,

This is our second letter of 1985 and is being sent to you to remind you of several very important stamp club items.

We are now winding down our Philatelic Year, but there are many events remaining in 1985. The first, of course, is that our meetings continue to be held on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month at 8:00 P.M. (doors open at 7:00 P.M.) at the Orlando Science Center, 810 East Rollins Street. Our meetings will be on Thursday, 7 November 1985 with Bill Jones giving one of his inimitable presentations on something Latin; Thursday, 21 November 1985, the fourth auction of the year (members are limited to 3 lots per member until a total of 60 lots has been received; club donation lots will be accepted in addition to the 60 lot limit); Thursday, 5 December 1985, Bill Bomar gives his annual "Something U.S." presentation; Thursday, 19 December 1985 is the Annual Holiday Party - more on that later.

The Club is committed to 104/112 9-page frames of exhibits for the Annual Club Show, SUNPEX '85, to be held on Saturday and Sunday, 7 and 8 December 1985 (Hours, Saturday, 10 to 6; Sunday, 10 to 4) at the Orlando EXPOCENTER, 500 West Livingston Street, Orlando 32801. Plenty of free parking. As soon as this letter is in the mail, Bill and I will get on the phone and start calling you for your exhibit! I know that all are familiar with our frames, each of which holds 9 standard album pages. You are the folks that wanted the Club Show, so now we need YOUR exhibits. You may have as many frames for your exhibits as you desire. Any and all are most welcome. We also need a lot of transportation on both Saturday and Sunday to get the frames from our storage place (Bill's home) to the EXPOCENTER; a lot of help to set up and take down the show; and to take the frames back to storage when the show is over. Please volunteer the use of your station wagon, pick-up truck, van, or whatever, with you driving!!! We also need lots of help at the Club Table. The Show Cachet - Salute to the Rollins College Centennial, 1885-1985 - Serving Youth - will sell for \$1.00 per cover and is already printed. The club publicity should be appearing in the philatelic press NOW. Member Phil Fettig indicated that the 30-dealer Bourse is completed and will be ready to provide for your collecting wants and needs.

To recap, for the SUNPEX '85 we need many exhibits, a lot of transportation, many members to work the Club Table, etc. Forgot to mention that the U.S. Postal Service will have a temporary station at the SUNPEX '85 and that the Show Cancel has been approved for the show.

The ANNUAL HOLIDAY PARTY will be held at the home of our Most Gracious Treasurer, Mrs. Jane C. Morrison, 1302 Lake Shore Drive, Orlando, 32803, on THURSDAY, 19 December 1985, at 7:00 P.M. I think that most, if not all, of you know where Mrs. Morrison lives, so will not publish the map. However, for those in doubt, Lake Shore Drive is the "extension" of Rollins Street east of Mills Avenue (US 17-92), and is the first home on the right side (going east) of the street. Plenty of parking. The Club provides a center piece of hors d'oeuvres, coffee and tea. We request that attendees bring a plate of Christmas Goodies (cookies, candies, or that type of good stuff (YOU know what to bring) for the festive table. Mrs. Morrison indicated that she will be calling many spouses for assistance with the party. (REMEMBER, NO meeting at the Orlando Science Center on 19 December.)

We still have 34 unsponsored Exhibit Frames. The sponsorship of a frame is \$11.00 per frame, and we get a nice metal plate to attach to the top of the frame which reads: "Frame Donated by (name)".

We will need many members to tend this table for the two days of the show which will be held at the Best Western Catalina Inn, at the 33rd Street Exit off I-4. Plenty of Parking.

For those of you who did not get to attend the FLOREX at St. Petersburg Beach this past weekend, you sure missed a great show. There were more Gold Awards presented at this show than I have seen in many, many years, and the caliber of all the Exhibits was tremendous. Absolutely scrumptious. We were pleased to see many of the Central Florida Stamp Club members in attendance.
