Dear Fellow Members,

This is our first letter of 1987.

1987 dues are now due and payable - \$10.00 per member; \$5.00 for Junior Members.

The 1987 PROGRAM is attached. Please note that after having the program reproduced for distribution that we LOST our meeting room on our regularly scheduled date of April 16th due to "camping night" for the kids in the entire Science Center. We have a replacement date which I have changed in red ink on the program to the 23rd of April. A couple of other small changes which affect only the room for meetings on June 4 (Auditorium), June 18, July 2 and July 16 (the last three of which will be held in the TAM Room which is immediately to your right at the base of the ramp in the long hallway). PLEASE NOTE CHANGES.

Our first AUCTION on Thursday, March 19th, is the ANNUAL CLUB DONATION AUCTION. Treasurer John Shirley made a proposal at our Annual Business Meeting that we have a GOODIE. To this end John has proposed that each member can submit their want list to him (telephone 788-6067) of up to five different stamps each of which must have a 1987 Scott Catalog value not exceeding \$50.00 EACH. You must open bidding at a minimum of 50% of 1987 Scott. John will then attempt to obtain at least one of these items for you, more if possible, all through DONATIONS for the Club Treasury. President Bill Bomar will grade all stamps submitted to ensure quality. All stamps to be a minimum of FINE. In this connection, I would like to point out that this special does not rule out the normal Donation Lots for the ANNUAL CLUB DONATION AUCTION. Also, John Shirley will be away for about a week to 10 days - however he does have an answering service to record your messages and he will contact you on his return.

Concerning all other auctions during the year. Each member is limited to submitting 3 lots per auction (Donation lots will always be accepted in addition to these lots, and will be the first lots auctioned during the sale). However, if we do not obtain the maximum number of 60 lots (exclusive of Donation Lots) members will be called upon to enter any additional lots she or he may have until such time as we reach the 60 lot limit. Those individuals having more than 3 lots to enter will have their names placed on a list and will be called in turn for their additional lots. Our rental agreement requires that we leave the building by 10:00 P.M. We have to collect for lots sold; pay the owners (on other than donation lots); and it does take an extra-ordinarily long period of time to sell those 60 lots as all of you know. We gotta speed up the auctions!!!!!

At the Annual Business Meeting, President Bill Bomar created an award - and has generously donated \$100.00 1987 Scott Catalog Value in stamps as the PRIZE. This prize will be given to the member who attends the most meetings during 1987. In the case of a tie, the value will be divided amongst those who tie. It is therefore most important that each of you sign the attendance register legibly at the entrance to the meeting room. Thank you, Bill, for your generosity.

ANOTHER CHANGE. Phil Fettig's Quarterly Show at the Lee Road Sheraton has been moved to Saturday, February 28th (10 A.M. to 6 P.M.) and Sunday, March 1st (10 A.M. to 4 P.M.) instead of February 21-22, 1987 dates previously published (Over)

and now appearing in the philatelic press. PLEASE NOTE THIS CHANGE!

We have included the dates for the Florida Federation of Stamp Clubs, Inc. Spring Meeting (STAMPOREE '87) and the Fall Meeting (FLOREX '87) on our calendar with dates and places. Do you know that the Central Florida Stamp Club is a charter member of the Federation - joining when it was formed in 1949? Do you know that the Florida Federation of Stamp Clubs, Inc., is the only organization that I know of in the U.S. of A. that has TWO shows per year that are approved by the American Philatelic Society in that organization's CHAMPION OF CHAMPION'S shows? FLOREX '87 will be held at the Orlando Expo Centre on November 6, 7 and 8, 1987. We will again, this year, need lots and lots of you good folks to participate in setting up the frames for the exhibits, putting the exhibits in the frames, attend the registration and hospitality tables, take down the exhibits and pack them to mail back to owners, take down the exhibit frames and put them in their storage containers and ready them for return to the storage warehouse. If you have never had the opportunity to participate in this type of philatelic endeavor, consider this your unique opportunity because will will be seeking your help, assistance and muscle!!

A sincere thanks to all who operated the Club Table at the Greater Orlando Stamp, Coin and Postcard Show at the High Q Inn on Saturday and Sunday, January 31 and February 1. Remember, it takes a lot of hauling of the frames, preparation of exhibits, setting up frames, mounting exhibits, judging, taking down the exhibits and frames and returning the frames to storage, as well as operation of the Club Tables.
