

### Priceless Memory by JDS

As WW2 European campaign was winding down, the 500 bed 74th Station Hospital was ordered to Bologna to service the Fifth Army in Northern Italy. A large private hospital was taken over for USA troops. The wounded came in so fast that most non-medical personnel assisted in the unloading of ambulances. Included with our wounded were some German soldiers. The hospital was so crowded that some of the Germans had to be left on stretchers for lack of hospital beds. The Fifth Army was aware of our problem. They captured a complete German Field Hospital doctors, nurses and orderlies, tagged them as wounded and send them back. When they arrived at our hospital, they became healthy and were assigned to take care of the German patients. Now we have former enemies working together in the same building taking care of the suffering. There were no problems. The Germans appreciated the medical care, food and facilities. The US Army was RESPECTED because we had earned a victory in battle and had not offer a "Prague" type appeasement.

One Sunday afternoon, I took time off and visited the park area of the hospital. A young Italian approached me and wanted to talk, his English was better than my Italian, and we talked a long time about the USA. Then I asked him about his background. He had worked as a clerk in the local Post Office. I then informed him that I had started a W/W stamp collection. He then pulled an envelope from his pocket. This envelope contained a complete set of the last Italian Issue under Mussolini. This was Scott's # 444/459 are mounted on a page in my Italian collection. The catalog value is \$10.20, a dealer would sell them for about \$3.00. To me - they are PRICELESS - a memory of a Sunday afternoon in Bologna, Italy.
