

A Short Transport

Sometimes things just happen. I recently bought this cover because it is pretty. Yes — I am shallow at times. This cover would have been so much more attractive — if it actually had the complete set of stamps. The 6^{ξ} booklet is missing as is the 8^{ξ} value from the set. You may ask why?

There is actually a very good reason for only having six of the stamps in the Transport series on this cover dat-



ed 10.29.1941. The booklet pane of six that is known as C25a was not issued until 03.18.1943 and C26 was issued 03.21.1944 — nearly 2.5 years after the date of this cover.

Interestingly this cover is a FDC for only the 50¢ stamp which had a first issue date of 10.29.41. The remaining stamps are just there for the ride — to make it look pretty. I have to say it does look pretty! So — what have you bought recently that was purchased just because it was pretty? Do tell.

The Central Florida Stamp Club is a 70+ year old organization governed by a Board of Directors elected by the general membership every two years and dedicated to the enjoyment of the hobby of stamp collecting.
